Over the past five years we impacted the lives of over 7,000 patients and their families. Since the first patient came through our doors on September 13th, 2017

- 13,000 patients have been admitted in our Neuro ICU and Neuro Step Down units
- 3,600 stroke patients have been treated
- 3,200 endovascular procedures have been performed
- 350 brain aneurysm patients have been treated

In conjunction with these achievements, we are proud to be the first and only Comprehensive Stroke Center on the South Shore of Long Island, certified by the Joint Commission and the New York Department of Health, the highest such recognition nationally. Additionally, we created the first Neuro Intensive Care Unit in Suffolk County, brought multiple clinical trials to our institution, and several new devices were used for the first time in our center.
